





About Scottsdale







- A user-friendly map tool that helps individuals find properties, check license statuses, and contact owners directly.





“Since launch, we’ve seen a 60% decrease in short-term rental complaints and increased direct communication between neighbors. Staff resources have shifted from reactive complaint handling to proactive enforcement and education. The platform continues to improve as feedback flows in.”
